MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: Commander's Environmental Policy

1. Purpose: Define the Fort Hamilton Environmental Policy.
2. Applicability: Policy applies to all Fort Hamilton personnel, including Soldiers, civilians, visitors and contractors.
3. Policy – As the Garrison Commander, my policy is:
 - a. Continuously strive to improve performance while complying with applicable Federal, State, U.S. Army, and local environmental laws, regulations, and executive orders.
 - b. Embrace a commitment to environmental stewardship as an integral part of our mission to ensure sustainability and meet the needs of the Soldiers today and in the future.
 - c. Maintain an installation-wide Environmental Management System (EMS) in accordance with Executive Order 13423 and International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001 that is focused on initiatives with potential to enhance and improve environmental performance.
 - (1) Reestablish the Environmental Quality Control Committee (EQCC), and it will meet quarterly, in conjunction with the EMS Cross Functional Team (CFT) meetings.
 - (2) The EQCC will consist of members representing the operational, logistics, engineering, planning, resource management, legal, medical, environmental, morale, welfare, and recreation (FMWR), commissary, exchange service, and safety interests of the command, including military installation tenant activities.
 - d. Seek and identify pollution prevention opportunities to continually minimize the installation environmental footprint and conserve resources.
 - e. Provide quality installation services, enhance mission readiness, and promote well-being in a safe and secure environment.
