MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Commander's Weapons Handling Policy

1. PURPOSE: To establish weapons handling procedures for personnel assigned to the Fort Hamilton, Directorate of Emergency Services (DES).

2. APPLICABILITY: Applicable to all personnel assigned Law Enforcement duties as Department of the Army Civilian Police (DACP) officers for the Fort Hamilton DES.

3. REFERENCES: MG Horst MOR dated 10 October 2010, ALARACT 135/2010, AR 350-4, DA PAM 350-38, FM 23-35, FM 23-88, FM 19-5, STP 21-12-SMCT.


4. PROCEDURES: The following procedures will be adhered to by all assigned DACP Officers performing Law and Order Operations on Fort Hamilton.

a. DACP officers will carry three magazines for the M9 pistol while in the performance of their duties. Each magazine will hold fifteen rounds of 9mm ammunition, for a total of forty-five (45) 9mm rounds.

b. DACP officers will be issued A260 9mm Jacketed Hollow Point (JHP) rounds. The A260 JHP rounds will be supplied by the Fort Dix Ammunition Supply Point (ASP), and issued to the individual officers by the DES. Commercial JHP rounds are not authorized.

c. DACP officers are authorized to carry their M9 duty pistols in 'Condition Red'. This weapons status consists of a fully loaded magazine inserted into the weapon, a round chambered, and the safety lever in the 'SAFE' position.
