

MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: Environmental Policy

1. PURPOSE: Define the Fort Hamilton Environmental Policy.
2. APPLICABILITY: Policy applies to all personnel on Fort Hamilton, including Soldiers, Civilians, visitors and contractors.
3. POLICY.
  - a. Our mission is to provide quality installation services, support, and facilities to enhance mission readiness and promote wellbeing in a safe and secure environment.
  - b. Identify and address pollution prevention opportunities to meet or exceed Army sustainability goals.
  - c. Strive for performance beyond compliance with applicable Federal, State, U.S. Army, and local environmental laws, regulations, and executive orders.
  - d. Continually assess activities to determine environmental impacts and integrate environmental awareness into day-to-day mission planning and execution. Consider these impacts when selecting objectives and performance targets in an ISO 14001 conformant Environmental Management System that is installation-wide and focused on continual improvement.
  - e. Document, maintain, and communicate this policy internally within Fort Hamilton and externally to the general public.
