MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Fort Hamilton Juvenile Curfew Policy

1. **PURPOSE.** To improve the quality of life within the Fort Hamilton community by increasing parental supervision and control of children within the community.

2. **SCOPE.** This policy letter applies to all assigned or attached personnel (military and civilian) who have family members or visitors under the age of 18 who are physically present on Fort Hamilton. It also applies to persons under the age of 18 who are physically present on Fort Hamilton.

3. **DISCUSSION.**

a. Child supervision is necessary for the safety, protection, and care of children within the community.

b. Child supervision is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Parents/guardians will know the whereabouts of their children and their activities at all times.

c. Parents/guardians are accountable for the actions of their children or children under their guardianship.

4. **POLICY.**

a. **CURFEW.** Effective immediately the following curfew is imposed for the Fort Hamilton community and will remain in effect until such time that it is changed by the undersigned.

(1) Children under the age of 18 years who reside on the installation shall be inside of quarters between the hours of 2200-0600, Monday through Thursday and 2300-0600, Friday through Sunday. If children are not inside of quarters during the hours of curfew, they must be accompanied by an adult 21 years of age or older, or returning home from a community organized function or facility (for example, the Fort Hamilton Fourth of July celebration or High School Prom), or traveling between home and a location that can be verified by the parent or guardian (for example, babysitting, or other employment).


SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Fort Hamilton Juvenile Curfew Policy – Command Policy

Children under the age of 18, who do not reside on the installation, must depart the installation by 2200 hours, Monday through Thursday and 2300 hours, Friday through Sunday.

(2) Parents/guardians are ultimately responsible for compliance with this policy. If a child is released to the custody of another adult during the period of the curfew, that adult assumes full responsibility for the child and any actions that the child may become involved in. If a child is in the custody of another adult during the period of curfew, the parent must have authorized the adult in advance to supervise the child.

(3) Military Police will enforce this policy as directed. Violators will be positively identified and referred to the Garrison Commander for further actions.

(4) Failure to comply with the policies set forth in this memorandum may result in referral to the Juvenile Disciplinary Control Board, or in the case of a child who does not reside on the installation, termination of the sponsor's government quarters.
